The Library Board services the entirety of Lac La Biche County, including the surrounding Indigenous communities, and provides leadership in delivering a variety of quality materials and services that is welcoming and respectful.

The Board meets up to 6 evenings a year at the Bold Center location for approximately 3 hours per meeting and is seeking 1 Board Member for a three (3) year term commencing as soon as practical.
