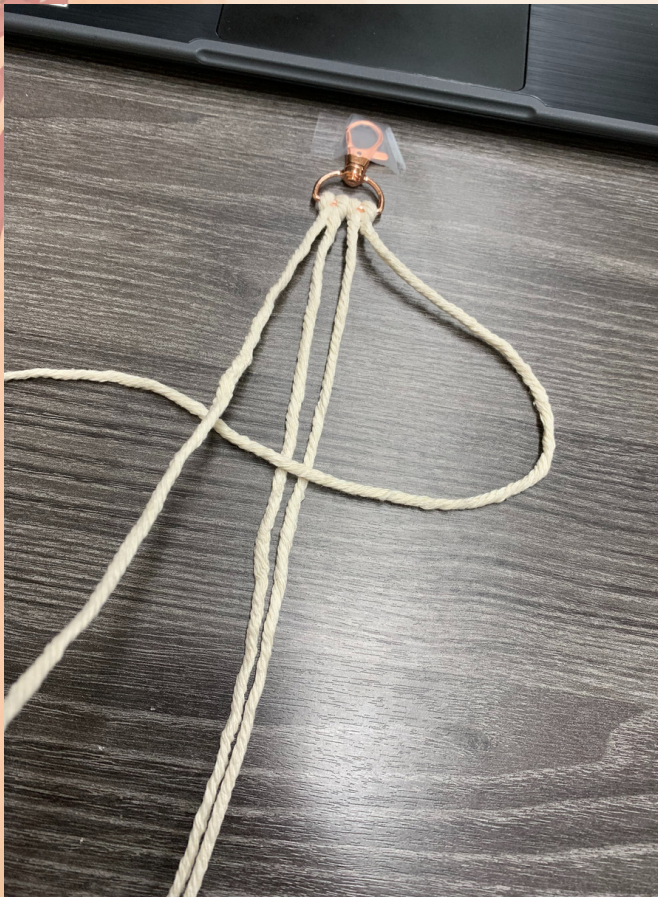


The first step is a Lark's head knot. Fold each string in half. Take the loop of your folded string and put it through the key ring. then pull the tails through. Repeat for your second string.

The outside strings will be our working strings pick any side you'd like to start with, I chose the right side. Cross the right string over the middle strings.

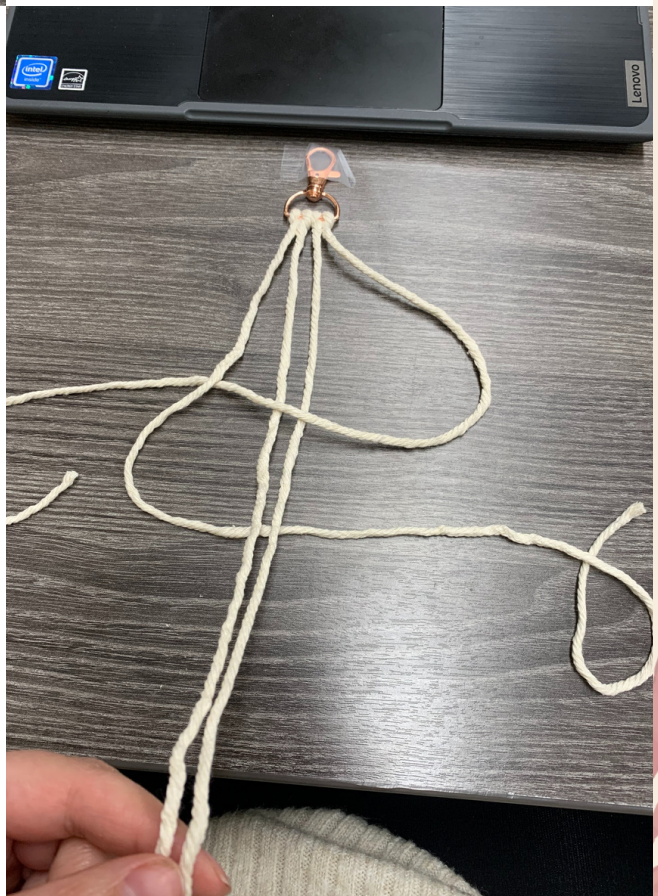




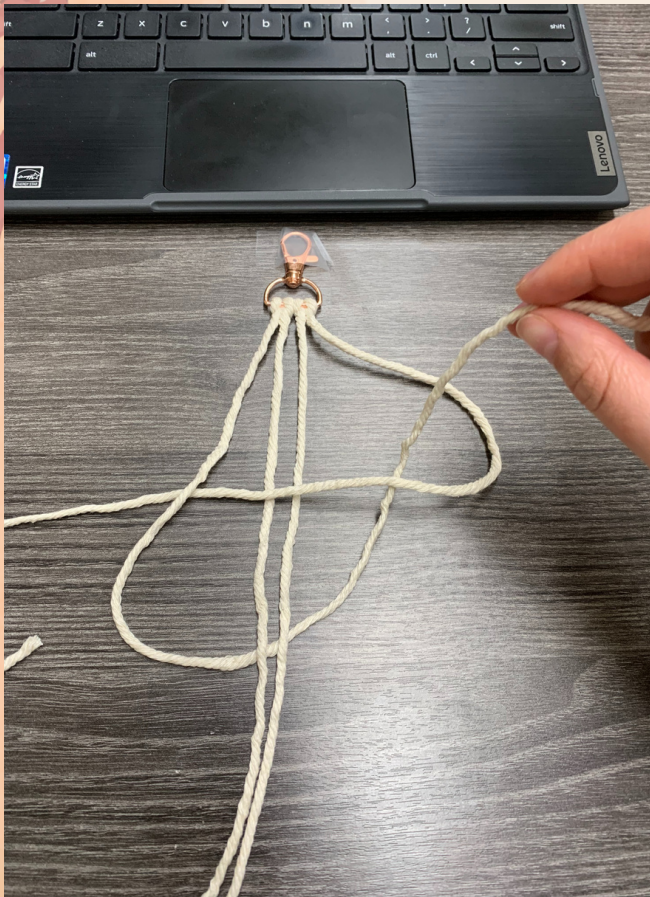


Take the left string

middle strings



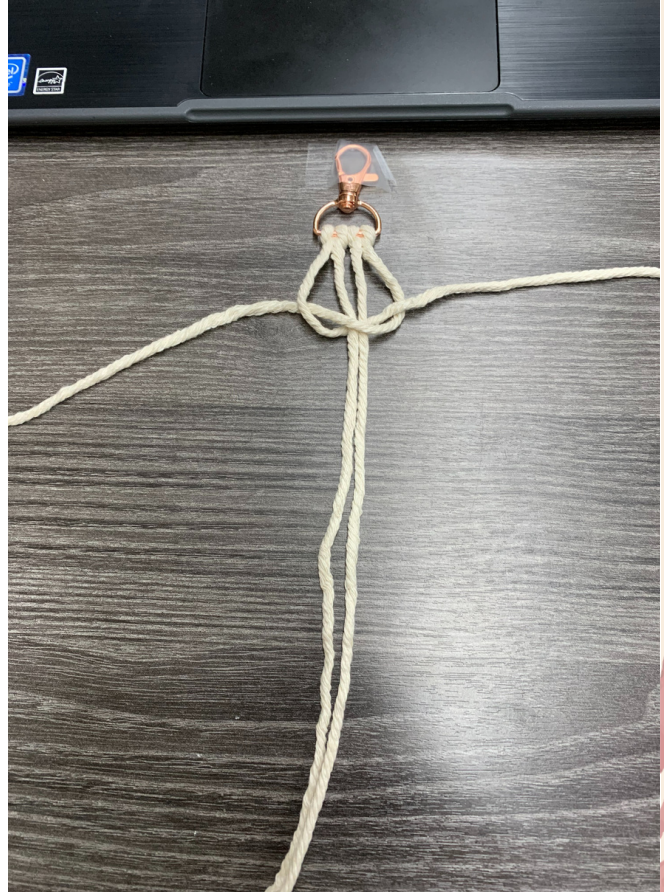




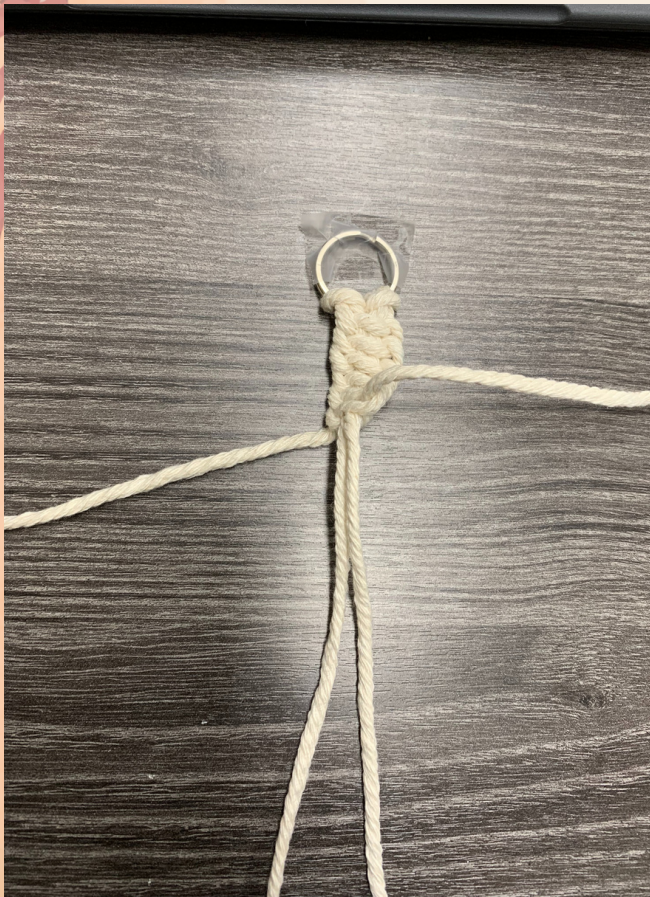
Take the left string and pull it under the loop we made with the right string.

Pull both ends together to make a knot at the top.

Repeat the steps starting on the same side.

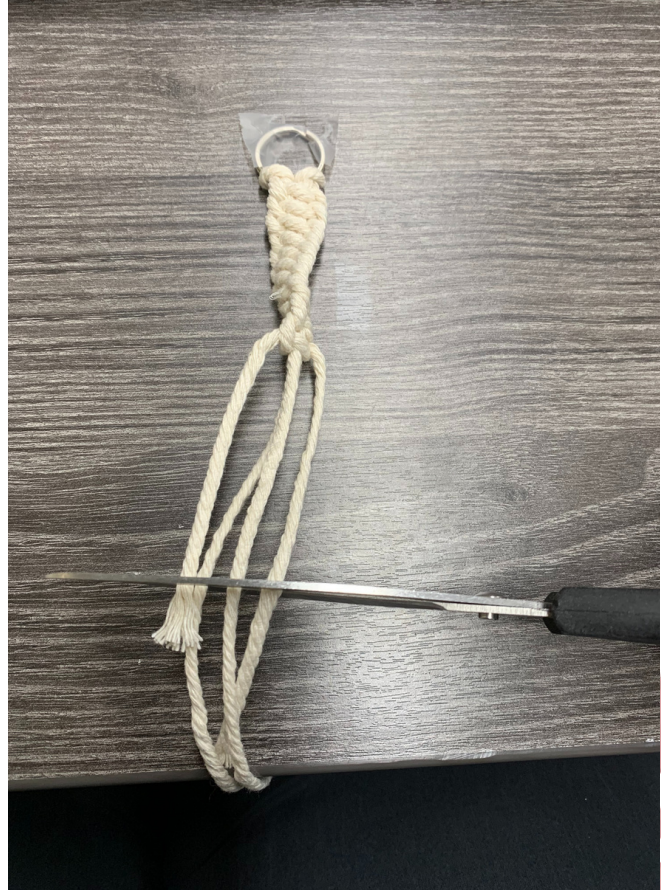




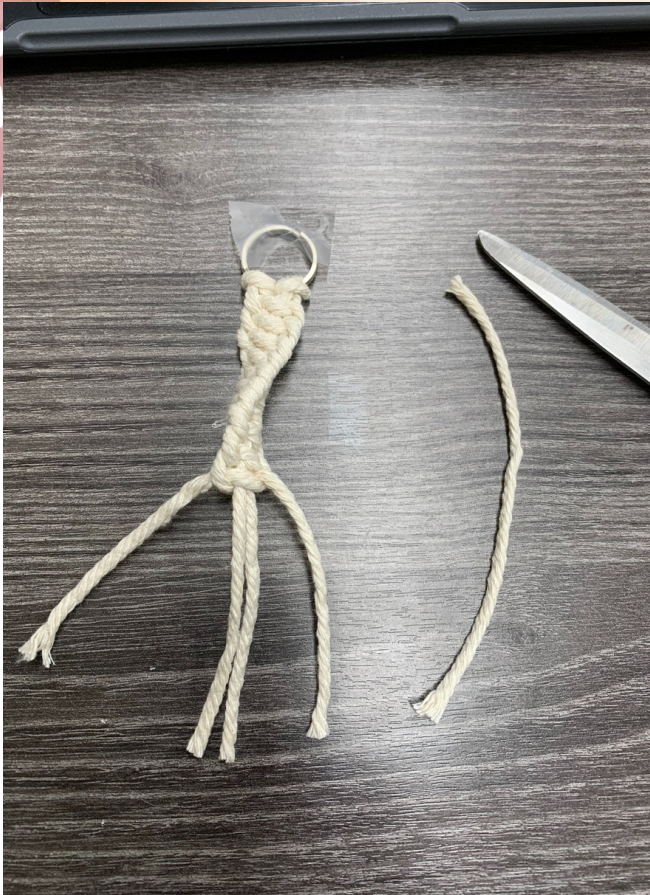


Your keychain will start to turn. If it gets difficult you can the keychain to the table straight.

When your strings are getting short cut all of them to an equal length.





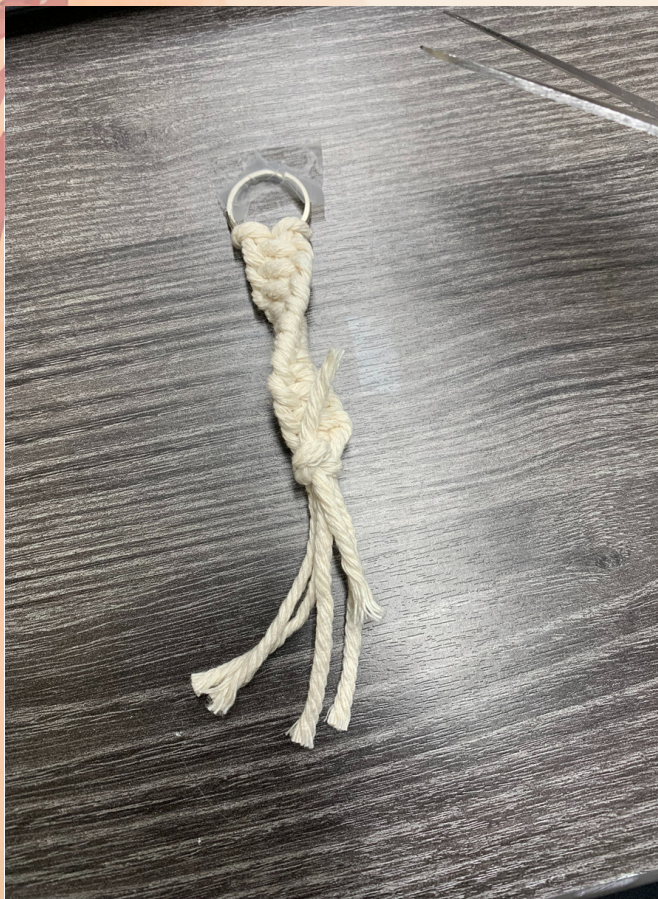


Take one of the longer ends you cut off

We are going to use this string to tie off the end.







Trim the ends of the knot and your keychain is done!
