

Painted Chocolates

You'll need

1. White Chocolate
2. Toothpicks
3. Food Safe Paint Brush
4. Candy Colouring
5. Microwave and Freezer (Not Included)
6. Microwavable Bowls (Not Included)
7. Chocolate Moulds (Not Included)



Instructions

1. Take about 12oz of chocolate, divide into microwave safe bowls. Use as many bowls as colours you would like!
2. Microwave at half power for 15 second intervals. Stir every time you microwave.
3. Once chocolate is melted, stir in candy colouring. You can use toothpicks or spoons from home!
4. Take a paint brush and scoop the melted chocolate into the brush. Paint the moulds, once they harden you can continue to make multiple layers. Be as creative as you want!
5. Ensure the moulds are full.
6. Once complete, tap the moulds gently on the counter to bring any air bubbles to the top.
7. Place chocolate filled moulds in the freezer for as little as 10min. Once chocolates are completely hardened, remove them from the moulds.
8. Enjoy your treats!
